--Provides limited grant funding through the Illinois Housing Development Authority (IHDA), Rental Housing Support Program (RHSP), or the Illinois Department of Human Services (IDHS) Homelessness Prevention Grant. These programs allow Lazarus House to provide assistance with rent, mortgage and utilities. To receive help, funds must be available and individuals must qualify according to government grant requirements.
